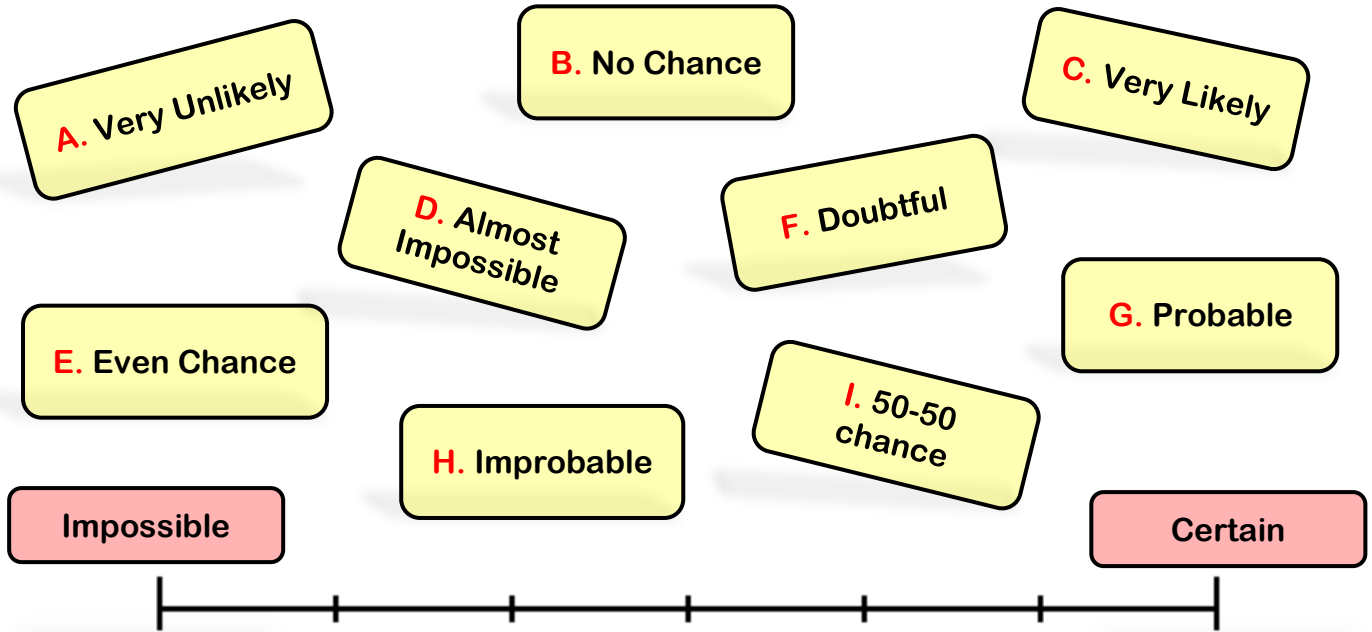


# The Language of Probability



## Section A

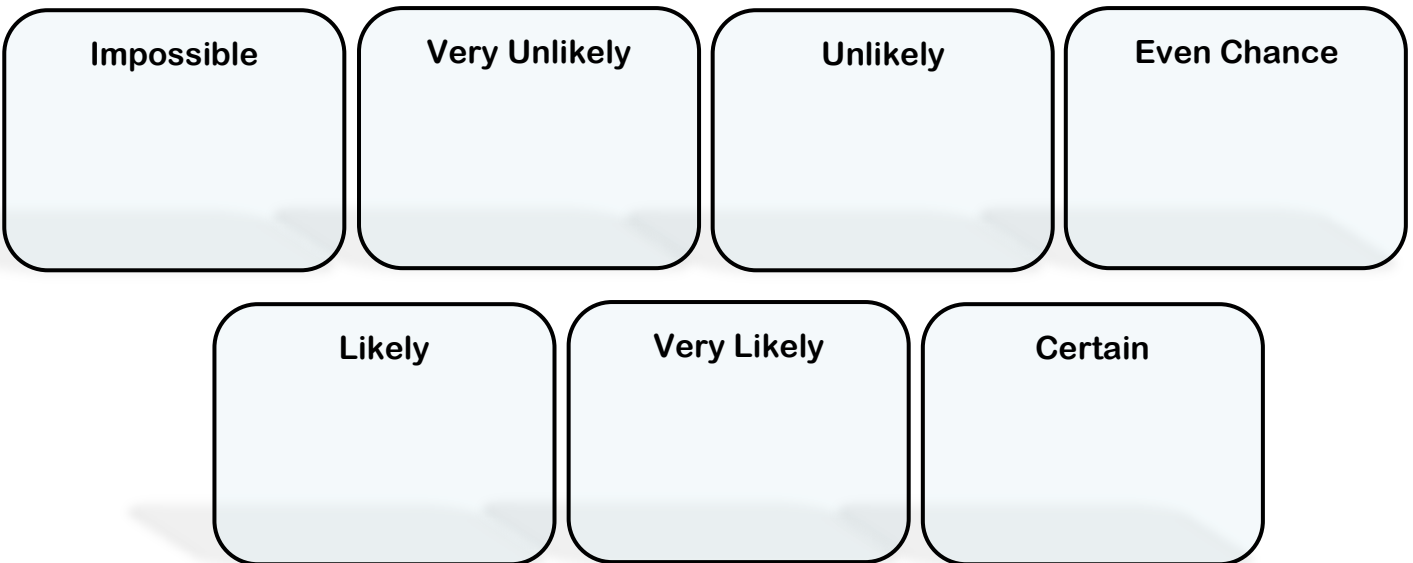
Place the words somewhere on the scale, going from impossible to certain.
